

BELMONT HIGH SCHOOL PARENT/STUDENT CONTRACT

This contract states the rules that must be followed at the Senior All Night Graduation Party (ANP). By signing your name to the contract you acknowledge the following rules and will abide by them. It is understood that if you violate this code of conduct, you will be subject to the consequences as listed below. Both student and parent must sign this contract in order to buy a ticket and attend the All Night Party

Rules and Consequences:

- Student must arrive between 9:00 pm and 10:00 pm for the ANP. No one will be admitted after 10:00 pm.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: Student will be denied admission.**
- Student must remain within the physical boundaries of the ANP area. Students may not leave the ANP early unless parents are notified by an ANP chaperone or unless parents have notified ANP organizers in advance of the party.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: If student is found beyond the specified areas, parent will be called and s/he will be sent home.**
- Inappropriate gestures, language, or behaviors will not be accepted.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: Parents will be called and students will not be allowed re-entry into the party.**
- The ANP is smoke free. This includes all areas of the ANP.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply.**
- Student must adhere to all school rules. No backpacks are allowed. Any pocketbooks/belongings will be searched. In addition, no beverages or containers may be brought into the ANP. Medications can be checked in with the nurse or doctor on duty.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply.**
- Students will attend the ANP alcohol and drug free. An administrator or nurse at the ANP will evaluate students if warranted. The school reserves the right to utilize any appropriate methodology to determine if a student is alcohol or drug impaired. It shall be a violation of the alcohol and drug policy for any student to display evidence of:
 - a. Using or having used alcohol and/or drugs.
 - b. Possessing alcohol and/or drugs.
 - c. Being knowingly in the presence of alcohol and/or drugs.
 - d. Transferring or transporting alcohol and/or drugs.
 - e. Knowingly or willfully assisting another person in using alcohol and/or drugs.
 ✚ **CONSEQUENCE: Parents will be notified immediately and student will be sent home. If a parent is not available, student will be placed in the custody of the local police department.**
